

# RIFLE CREEDMOOR SOULE LONG RANGE 4" - DAVIDE PEDERSOLI S.R.L RIFLE ADJUSTABLE TANG CREEDMOOR SOULE LONG RANGE 4" BLACK

Named after the famous range on Long Island that hosted many long-range rifle competitions in the 1870s and '80s, the Creedmoor ladder-type sight is fully adjustable for windage and elevation and works equally well on cartridge rifles and muzzleloaders. Sight is precision machined from steel and attaches to tang with supplied setscrews and folds down when not in use. The Universal model is available in middle-range 2" and long-range 3" heights. The windage adjustment mechanism is on the eyepiece, allowing the eyepiece to be dropped close to the base for close-in shots. The Soule model provides maximum adjustability to fit any hunting or target shooting conditions. Elevation is adjustable in precise increments of 1 MOA, and one full turn of the windage knob moves the point of aim left or right by 2½ MOA in ½ minute increments. Large knurled knob at the sight base allows fast, accurate return to center or previous setting. Choice of Short, Middle, and Long Range models. The "Goodwin" style sight was a popular sight for long range shooters in the late 1800s. The "flag" position allows for a very wide windage adjustment range of 1.26". The elevation adjustment on the Goodwin has a range of 3.94". With the Goodwin's structure, the chamber can be easily accessed for cleaning or inspection. The Goodwin also has a "tilt" screw that allows the staff to be perfectly vertical at all elevations.

# Safety Instruction Guide for RIFLE CREEDMOOR SOULE LONG RANGE 4"

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the RIFLE CREEDMOOR SOULE LONG RANGE 4" by DAVIDE PEDERSOLI S.R.L. This product is designed for precision shooting and target practice. To ensure your safety and the safety of others, please read this guide carefully before using the product.

2. For closein shots, lower the eyepiece close to the base.
3. Make adjustments in precise increments of 1 MOA for elevation and 2½ MOA for windage.
4. Always return the sight to the center or previous setting after use.

## Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the sight and any related components in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the sight with regular household waste.
- Consider recycling options if available in your area.
