The Stinger is constructed of premium saddle leather, fits belts up to 1 1/2" wide.

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the STINGER HOLSTERS GALCO INTERNATIONAL STINGER 1911 3" BLACKRIGHT HAND. This product is designed to provide a secure and accessible method for carrying your firearm. - To draw your firearm, grasp the grip firmly with your dominant hand while using your other hand to stabilize the holster.
- Pull the firearm straight out of the holster with a smooth motion.
- Always maintain proper firearm handling practices while drawing and holstering.

3. Cleaning and Maintenance:

- Wipe the holster with a dry cloth to remove dust and debris.
- If necessary, use a damp cloth with mild soap to clean the exterior. Avoid soaking the leather.
