Safety, security and stealth are all addressed with a covered trigger guard, deep molding and a tunnel-style belt loop that takes up little belt space compared to a pancake-type holster. The Stinger is constructed of premium saddle leather, fits belts up to 1 1/2" wide.

Safety Instruction Guide for STINGER HOLSTERS STINGER REMINGTON R51BLACKRIGHT HAND

Introduction
