A firm crimp improves accuracy because pressure must build to a higher level before the bullet begins to move. This higher start pressure insures a more uniform pressure curve and less velocity variation. Features a collet that squeezes the case mouth into the crimping groove for a firm hold. Shellholder not included. Fits all 7/8"-14 reloading presses.
