Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to +/-0.002". Machined from ultra-rigid, extruded 6061 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite for mounting.

- Tighten the screws gradually, applying a torque of 20 inch lbs.
- Apply a drop of blue loctite to each screw to secure them in place.

- Once installed, attach your Picatinny or Weaver scope rings to the scope base.
- Ensure that the scope is securely mounted and adjusted for eye relief.
- Conduct a function check to ensure the revolver operates correctly with the new scope base.

- Do not dispose of the product in regular household waste.
- Consider recycling options for the aluminum components where available.
