Drilled to fit the factory scope mount holes on those Winchester Model 70 long action rifles that use an .860 hole spacing on the front and rear receiver rings. Accepts Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Heavy Duty mounts are .100" lower than the Lightweight mounts to minimize weight and keep your optic closer to the barrel centerline for improved accuracy. Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to +/- .002". Machined from ultra-rigid extruded 7075 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Gather Required Tools:

- Socket head Torx wrench
- Torque wrench
- Blue Loctite (thread locker)

2. Installation Steps:

- Ensure the firearm is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
- Remove the existing scope mounts if applicable.
- Align the EGW Winchester 70 Heavy Duty Scope Bases with the factory scope mount holes on the receiver.
- Insert the socket head Torx screws into the designated holes.
- Tighten each screw gradually using the torque wrench to reach 20 inch lbs. Ensure even pressure

across all screws.

- Apply a small amount of blue Loctite to the threads of the screws before final tightening.

3. Usage Instructions:

- After installation, mount your Picatinny or Weaver scope rings as per the manufacturer's instructions.
- Adjust the eye relief as needed before securing the scope.
