

# BROWNING AB3 SHORT ACTION PICATINNY SCOPE MOUNT - EGW

## BROWNING AB3 SA 1-PIECE PICATINNY BASE 0 MOA

This mount comes standard with a bevel on both sides making it ambidextrous. EGW recommends measuring the hole spacing in your receiver to confirm it matches with the dimensions they have published. Picatinny cross slots run the full length of the rail, which gives the shooter flexibility when mounting scope rings and other accessories. The channel in the center reduces the overall mass of the mount. Also, in many cases, it will not obstruct usage of factory iron sights. Their one-piece scope mounts are the obvious choice for hunters and tactical shooters alike. They machine these in their shop using one of their machining centers. After machining, the mounts are tumbled, sand blasted, and Type II anodized for long lasting durability. Installation: EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite (loctite is sold separately). They recommend: 0 MOA - if shooting 0-500 yards 20 MOA - if shooting 500-1000 yards When zeroing your rifle with a 20 MOA mount, they recommend zeroing at 200 yards. The entire mount and accessories (from the mounting screws and wrench down to the packaging) are made in the USA.

- Insert the mounting screws through the mount into the receiver.
- Apply blue Loctite to the threads of each screw.
- Using a torque wrench, tighten each screw to 20 inch lbs. Do not overtighten.

### **3. Usage Instructions:**

- After installation, check the alignment of the scope.
- Adjust the scope to the desired settings based on the recommended MOA for your shooting distance:
  - 0 MOA for shooting 0500 yards.
  - 20 MOA for shooting 5001000 yards.
- Zero your rifle at 200 yards if using a 20 MOA mount.

### **4. Maintenance:**

- Regularly check the mount and screws for tightness and integrity.
- Clean the mount with a soft cloth to remove any dirt or debris.

## **Disposal Instructions**

- Dispose of the product and packaging in accordance with local regulations.
