Introduction

- Avoid dropping the magazine from heights greater than 8 feet, even though it has been tested for durability.
- In extreme thermal conditions (ranging from 60 to 180 degrees Fahrenheit), monitor the magazine for performance issues.
- Do not expose the magazine to harsh chemicals, including but not limited to DEET, fuels, and cleaners.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation:

- Ensure the firearm is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
- Align the magazine with the magazine well of your Glock® pistol.
- Firmly insert the magazine until it locks into place with an audible click.

2. Loading:

- Hold the magazine with the feed lips facing upwards.
- Insert ammunition into the magazine one round at a time, ensuring proper orientation.
- Do not exceed the magazine's capacity of 10 rounds.

3. Usage:

- Insert the loaded magazine into your firearm as described in the installation section.
- Ensure the slide locks back when the magazine is empty.

- To remove the magazine, press the magazine release button and pull the magazine out.

4. Disassembly for Cleaning:

- Remove the magazine from the firearm.
