# M&P SHIELD 9MM MAGAZINES SAFETY INSTRUCTION GUIDE

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the M&P Shield 9mm Magazines by Smith & Wesson. This guide provides essential safety information and usage instructions to ensure the safe handling and operation of your magazines. Please read this guide carefully before use.

- Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction.
- Press the magazine release button to remove the magazine.
- Pull the magazine straight out of the magazine well.

### 4. Unloading the Magazine

- Ensure the magazine is removed from the firearm.
- Press the follower down and remove each round one at a time.
- Store the magazine safely when not in use.

## **Disposal Instructions**

- Dispose of the magazine in accordance with local regulations.
- If the magazine is damaged or no longer usable, do not throw it in regular waste. Instead, take it to a designated recycling or hazardous waste facility.
